Thank you very much for your contribution of 2,354 pounds of food. Your support is invaluable to Connecticut Food Bank in our mission to alleviate hunger.

Connecticut Food Bank takes in food donated by growers, manufacturers, distributors, retailers and food drives and distributes it to more than 650 community-based programs throughout six Connecticut counties. In 2007, we distributed 15.3 million pounds of food and since our founding in 1982 we have distributed more than 171 million pounds of food.

Hungry children are not able to learn at the same pace as well-nourished children because they find it difficult to concentrate on their schoolwork.
