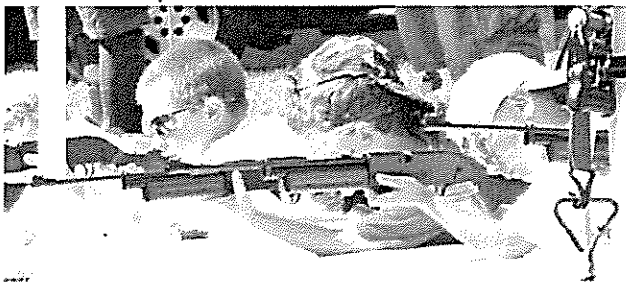

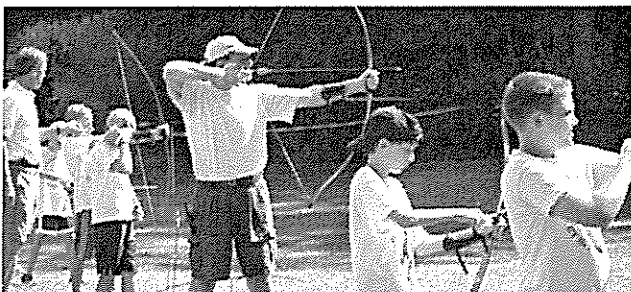




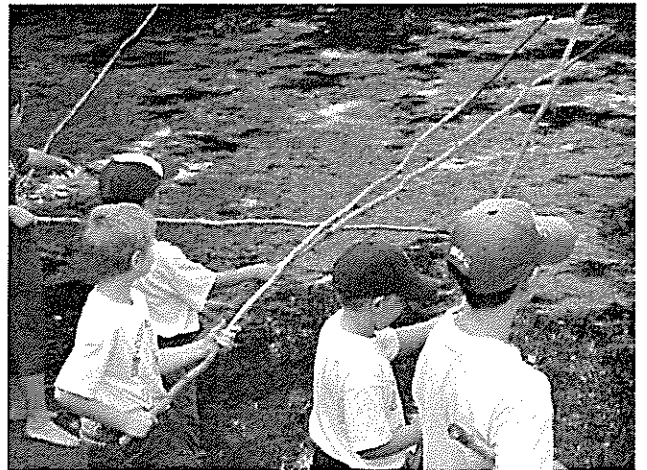
Clatter Valley Day Camp is in New Milford, CT. Clatter Valley is a city owned park. The Cub Scout Day Camp will be open July 26-30, 2010 and is staffed by local volunteers. The volunteers attend BSA camp school for day camp. The camp is inspected by local authorities, the State of Connecticut, and a Boy Scout camp visitation team.



Clatter Valley day camp operates Monday to Friday. Camp opens at 8:30 am and runs to 4 pm. The boys are supplied a snack during the day. Each camper brings his own lunch. Adults who volunteer for the entire week as den (leaders) guides are eligible for a rebate on their sons camp fees. Sibling support is offered for those leaders.



The Clatter Valley day camp operates on a schedule having the boys go to stations around the park. These stations include archery, sports and games, nature studies, bb guns, arts and crafts, Scout skills and other activities. The Camp is programmed for fun. This years camp theme is "The 100th Anniversary of Scouting". The theme will be applied to den projects and camp activities. All projects and activities are age appropriate, giving every boy an opportunity to try and *do his best* at each station.
